

REVENUE STAMPS OF ECUADOR

A Check List

by Charles M. Glase

This check list is based on the very extensive collection of Ecuador fiscals owned by Mr. Glase, plus information as given in Ecuador and other catalogues, and in articles which have appeared over the years.

It is likely that a very large percentage of these fiscals have been postally used at one time or another. Aside from chronically running short of certain values, it must be remembered that the majority of towns in Ecuador are not joined by railroad, and that existing roads are often trails. If this is true today, it was even truer in the late 1800's. Thus any given town could and did run out of certain values before new ones arrived.

This check list is subject to correction. There will undoubtedly be new fiscals reported and very probably some deletions. New information will have to come from collectors who go over this list. If you do find anything interesting please send it direct to Mr. Charles B. Glase, Central YMCA, Reading, Pennsylvania.

Please note that information on fiscals from 1948 to date is needed.

✓ Mr. Funkhouser has called to my attention the fact that #79 (1s Blue) is a color changeling. He says: "Try soaking a specimen of #78 (1s Green) in dilute hydrochloric acid and you'll get #79. The greens used on postage stamps are commonly made by mixing Prussian blue and lead chromate. A dilute acid will dissolve off the lead chromate leaving the Prussian blue. This also applies to #70 and 70A."

ADDENDA

In reply to my request for additional information I have received answers from two members who have pointed out very interesting and important varieties.

John W. Funkhouser, Director representing Ecuador, has called my attention to the following:

✓ "On the issue of 1899 1890 I find the 2c (#48) commonly to be overprinted with shaded, serif type, quite distinct from the usual unshaded, sans-serif type. (See illustrations #48 and 48a on page 127.)

✓ "Also I notice that your illustration of #57 of the 1891 1892 issue shows shaded, serif type, indicating that this issue, too, comes in both kinds of type." (See illustrations 57-57a on page 127.)

Mr. Leo John Harris writes:

✓ "There are two different types of overprint on the issue of 1921 1922 (#'s 360-369). The difference lies in the upper '1921'. (See illustrations 362-362a on page 127.)

Since hearing from Mr. Harris I have checked my duplicates and have found the reported variety to be only in the black overprint, and on all values except the 6s and 10s. Possibly these also exist. This '1921' variety also applies to the black overprinted stamps which were later overprinted 'SIN BIENIO' (#'s 417, 418, 421 and 423.)

✓ Mr. Harris also calls my attention to the 'TIMBRE PATRIOTICO' overprints. These have been found in two different sizes. I am not sure that this applies to all. (See illustrations 286-286a on page 127.)

Also illustrated on page 127 are two regular issue stamps with overprints about which information is completely lacking. Will members please continue to advise me of anything of interest they may find. Write: Charles B. Glase, Central YMCA, Reading, Pennsylvania.
