



Introduction



The American Bank Note Company in the United States of America was responsible for printing the majority of the paper money used by most of the Latin American countries between 1870 and 1970. For over one hundred years the American Bank Note Company produced some of the most beautiful banknotes ever made, and the quality of its work had earned the trust and respect from the world.

About fifteen years ago, the American Bank Note Company made a very important decision, due to the fact that most of their previous customers hadn't used their services for more than twenty years. A large number of countries that used to buy banknotes from the American Bank Note Company started producing their own banknotes in locally operated security printing companies. At that point, the American Bank Note Company decided to break down the archives department and sell a large amount of specimen and proof banknotes they had in their possession, through a series of auctions.

The auctions were very successful; the quality of the banknotes offered was truly spectacular, and the only down side was the fact that the archives had been broken apart forever. The archives department had very important records for thousands of different banknotes. These records deserved to be saved as a part of the American Bank Note Company history and the history of so many private banks and government issuing authorities throughout Latin America.

The objective of this book is to record all available information on banknotes produced by the American Bank Note Company to all Latin American countries from Argentina through Venezuela. Of course, as in any other historical research project, not every piece of information was found; but still, taking in consideration the period that this book covers and the number of banknotes listed (almost two thousand different banknotes from twenty different countries) one can say this is a very complete book.

This is a reference work; many of the banknotes listed in this book are very rare, and some only had been listed in the past as specimens and proofs. Today these banknotes have complete records with production dates, quantities printed, serial numbers and much more. Over the years one of the aspects of banknote collecting that was always in demand was knowledge. Publishing this book will establish a valuable tool for collectors and historians and I hope you may find it informative and exciting.

The system used to put this book together, due to the large amount of technical data available, was very simple: Countries and Banks are listed in alphabetical order and the banknotes are listed by denomination. Every banknote listed has a reference number ("Standard Catalog of World Paper Money" reference numbers have been added to the descriptions of each banknote to make it easier for collectors to identify their banknotes. Editions used were: *Specialized Issues, Volume One - 9th edition, General Issues, Volume Two - 10th Edition and Modern Issues, Volume Three - 9th Edition.*)

Information on production dates, quantity of banknotes printed, serial numbers and series letters are very complete through the records found. (Notes per plate, dates and signature records are not always available.) Under comments and observations you will find information on dates, signatures and also on different varieties of banknotes when records are available.

Production dates are a vital piece of information; now the age of each banknote can be determinate just by looking at the serial number of the banknote and taking in consideration that some banknotes were produced for more than a twenty year period, this will be an important tool to evaluate and to determine values of many banknotes in the future.

Serial number records are another break-through of this book; different banknotes may have serial numbers in sequence or different denominations also may have serial numbers in sequence; on other times serial numbers just don't start from the traditional number "one." Going through each banknote listed in this book, collectors will gain a new perspective on the serial numbers concepts used by the American Bank Note Company over the years.

Also, very important information has been discovered about serial number sequences, between banknotes printed by the American Bank Note Company and banknotes printed in Europe by companies like Bradbury, Wilkinson & Company, Thomas De La Rue and others; these records are one of the highlights of this book.

It's important to remark that many banknotes produced by the American Bank Note Company were delivered to their customers without dates or signatures, and in some cases banknotes were produced with one or two signatures and a second or third signature were left blank to be fill in by the bank afterwards; signatures could be engraved or just typed (printed) on each banknote.

Many banknotes printed by the American Bank Note Company have a date line engraved on them, also to be filled in by the bank at the time of issue of the banknote.

Series letters also can be engraved or typed on each banknote, or in some cases series letters were left blank to be typed by the customer afterwards. Sometimes the letters on the banknotes are check letters not series letters. To better understand this concept, let's take two sheets of four banknotes each; on the first sheet each banknote has a letter (A-B-C-D) and each banknote has the same serial number (1-1-1-1) -in this case the letters are series letters; on the second sheet each banknote has a letter (A-B-C-D) but each banknote has a different serial number (1-2-3-4) -in this case the letters are check letters.

Check letters are a simple system of checking the letter and serial number of the banknote, against the position on the sheet where the banknote was printed. In the early days this system was used to detect forgeries. Most of the records on check letters are missing from the American Bank Note Company archives, but if a large group of issued banknotes is available to research and the number of banknotes per sheets are known (Notes p/ plate) collectors can find out the location tabs of plates very easily; under the Brazilian section of this book you will find an extensive research of the check letters system.

The American Bank Note Company also used private marks (secret letters, marks and symbols added to the plates of each banknote) to detect forgeries on almost every plate made by them; a few records on this matter are found and listed through the book. (Most of these records were kept in special books where hundreds of banknote proofs with the location of each private mark were saved; unfortunately these books were not available for research purposes.)

Another important fact is, some banknote records from banknotes produced by the National Bank Note Company, Franklin-Lee Bank Note Company and other companies who were absorbed by the American Bank Note Company over the years, were found mixed in the archives; all records found from these companies were added to this book.

Suggestions or corrections concerning any aspect of the listings in this book are welcome for future editions.


